

IMPLANT FOLLOW UP CARE

For your implant longevity and health it is essential to follow the implant care protocol in a dental office.

- 2 weeks after implant restoration the occlusion (bite) has to be checked by a dentist to evaluate a proper occlusal relationship between the implant restoration and opposing teeth. The bone level and tissue status has to be evaluated by a dentist.
- 2 months after implant restoration the occlusion has to be checked by a dentist to evaluate a proper occlusal relationship between the implant restoration and opposing dentition. The bone level and tissue status (gum health) has to be evaluated by a dentist.
- The same protocol has to be followed every 6 months for 2 years
- Patients with more than 2 implants or experiencing bruxism need to wear a night guard fabricated by their dentist on daily basis.
- It is vital for the success for your implant treatment, that you maintain excellent oral hygiene. Brush and floss twice a day. Use antibacterial mouthwash at least once daily; please see your dentist for periodic hygiene visits as recommended by them. It is important to keep bacterial, plaque, and calculus levels at minimum around your implants.
