I do hereby release Pet Medical Center of San Antonio, their agents, employees or representatives from any and all liability while caring for my pet which may include transporting, medical and or emergency treatments. The owner agrees to remove the pet within 12 days after request for removal is made. Should the pet not be removed within the specified time, the owner hereby relinquishes all claim to the pet and Pet Medical Center of San Antonio is at liberty to humanely dispose of the pet as it may see fit.

FLEA CONTROL

For your pet's protection and to keep our facility free of fleas, ALL pets are given a CAPSTAR pill each time they are admitted for boarding. **There is a small fee of \$7.00.**



CONTAGIOUS DISEASE OPTION

- Every effort is made to insure that all pets admitted to our boarding facility are free of and vaccinated against contagious diseases. *Dogs: distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, parainfluenza, parvovirus, rabies. Cats: Viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, rabies, feline leukemia (FeLV).*
- Despite our best efforts and ability to control, contagious diseases are sometimes contracted while under our care. We are authorized, by your signature below, to commence treatment of any pet so effected, with the cost of care and treatment to be paid by you, before your pet may be discharged from our care.
- We offer an option for complete financial coverage for the treatment of contagious diseases (not injuries or other illnesses) listed above (excluding: rabies, FeLV, and Canine Influenza) while in our facility or for seven days following release, for the amount of \$4.95 per week or any part thereof.

Canine Influenza Vaccination (Dogs only)

Canine Influenza is a newly emerging canine disease

- The majority of dogs exposed to this virus are expected to show varying degrees of illness, ranging from mild/self-limiting respiratory symptoms, to severe/life-threatening pneumonia.
- Infected dogs can be shedding the virus before showing symptoms, therefore it is impossible for Pet Medical Center to know if a dog has already been exposed (“carrier”) to the virus before entering their facility for boarding.
- It is impossible for Pet Medical Center to guarantee that your dog will not be exposed to a carrier dog while boarding in their facility.
- A vaccine is available for Canine Influenza. Administration of the vaccine does not guarantee that your dog will not contract influenza if exposed, but it is expected to decrease the severity and duration of symptoms.
- Similar to other vaccines, administration of the influenza vaccine may result in adverse effects, including pain at the injection site, allergic reactions, and rare life-threatening reactions.
- Vaccination for Canine Influenza is a series of two injections given 3-4 weeks apart. Your dog will not be fully immunized until after both injections are given. If at the time of admission your dog has not been vaccinated or has received only one vaccination for influenza, your dog is not protected.

I have read the above information about Canine Influenza. I understand the benefits and risks of vaccination. I agree to not hold Pet Medical Center responsible if my dog contracts influenza or an influenza-like illness during or after boarding in their facility, even if my dog is vaccinated for influenza. If my dog begins to show symptoms of influenza or influenza-like illness while boarding, I consent to medical treatment and agree to pay the fees incurred for such treatment.
